erchange : v rotary under the interchange connects the 20 to Decarie expressway and the Champlain


Bridge A new elevated highway connects North-South through traffic. East-West through traffic is directed under the rotary to the Ville Marie Expressway.

The obsolete ramps of the Turcot Interchange are transformed into a 21st century planted promenade.

The lac à la loutre urban boulevard borders the highway 20 parkway whose speed is reduced to 70km/h in the neighborhood.







